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GREEN BLUFF PASTURES POLICIES AND AGREEMENT

In consideration for my dog being permitted to be a client at Green Bluff Pastures for boarding, I make the following representations and agree to all of the following policies, procedures, terms, and conditions:

1. **REQUIREMENTS.** My dog meets the following criteria: it is four (4) months of age or older, spayed/neutered (if over six (6) months), current on Rabies, Distemper, and Bordetella, in good general health, flea—and tick-free, not aggressive, has a quick-release collar, and meets all relevant state/county licensing.
2. **PERSONAL PROPERTY.** Green Bluff Pastures is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property. Collars may be removed for safety in group play.
3. **AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOR.** Aggressive dogs are not permitted. If a dog exhibits aggression, Green Bluff Pastures may consult with the owner and disallow further attendance at its sole discretion.
4. **ABANDONMENT.** Dogs must be picked up at their scheduled time. They will be relinquished to a local shelter or rescue if they are abandoned. Green Bluff Pastures assumes no further responsibility for abandoned pets.
5. **DISCLOSURE.** I agree to disclose all known medical, behavioral, or personality issues that may impact care or safety.
6. **ASSUMPTION OF RISK.** I understand there are inherent risks with group dog care, including illness, injury, or death. I assume full responsibility for my dog's participation, including all veterinary expenses incurred.
7. **MEDICAL CARE.** I authorize Green Bluff Pastures to seek veterinary care if needed. I agree to cover all related medical and transportation costs.
8. **PHOTOS.** I allow Green Bluff Pastures to use images of my dog for social media and marketing purposes.
9. **RELEASE & WAIVER.** I release, hold harmless, and indemnify Green Bluff Pastures and its affiliates from any liability arising from services rendered, including injury or illness to me, my dog, or others.
10. **LATE PICK-UP POLICY** Pick-up after closing hours (6:00 PM) will incur a late fee of \$10 per dog, every 15 minutes past closing. Dogs not picked up by 7:00 PM may be boarded overnight at the owner's expense.
11. **DEPOSIT & CANCELLATION POLICY** To confirm a boarding reservation, a non-refundable deposit of 20% of the total boarding cost is required during scheduling. This deposit secures your booking and will be applied toward your final invoice. Cancellations or no-shows will forfeit this deposit.

COMMON VIRUSES AND INFECTIONS WAIVER

Just like taking your child to daycare, your dog can get ill, too. Even though we have a spotless environment, they can bring infections from dog parks, other daycares, etc. By sharing the water and toys, they may inevitably contract something.

The following is a list of common viruses and infections. It is essential to know the symptoms and call us if you suspect they have something:

Bordetella – “The common cold.” Just because they’ve received the vaccination doesn’t mean they still can’t get the virus. The symptoms are coughs that won’t stop, almost like something is stuck in their throat. Another common symptom is vomiting, which is a foamy substance. Many dogs can get over the cold independently without a veterinarian. Nevertheless, some cases can turn into something else, and antibiotics may be needed—e.g., pneumonia or bronchitis.

Influenza – “The Dog Flu.” Just because they’ve received the vaccination doesn’t mean they still can’t get the virus. Symptoms are throwing up, refusing to eat and/or drink, vomiting, and diarrhea. They must stay hydrated and nourished. If you suspect your dog has the flu, please call us immediately. We have tips on how to get them to eat and drink.

Conjunctivitis. This is a green/yellow mucus discharge from the eye. Conjunctivitis is very common in daycare. There’s plenty of dirty hair flying around, and it can get into your dog’s eyes. They can’t wipe their eyes like we can, so it can become an infection. We have eye drops (containing Boric Acid) that usually work if caught in the early stages. If not treated early enough, they will need to see a vet.

Giardia is a widespread intestinal infection in dogs. One way to contract it is by drinking from a river or mud puddle. If you notice your dog experiencing diarrhea, greasy stool, foul gas, foul belching, or abdominal bloating, a vet check may be in order.
